

Content	Video includes <u>all</u> vocabulary including expressions in appropriate context.	Most vocabulary is used, although some may be missing or not in an appropriate context.	Not all of the vocabulary is included or improperly used.	Much of the vocabulary is lacking or there are many errors in usage.	Very little vocabulary was used and/or not included in sentences. Page number <u>12</u>
Pronunciation	Pronunciation is clear with careful attention to French pronunciation rules.	Pronunciation is good overall, with some attention paid pronunciation rules.	Some sounds are difficult to understand.	A sympathetic listener would be able to understand you.	Too many inaccuracies impede understanding.
Effort	The students include a variety of ways to address the topic. Circumlocution and complex sentences structure is included to adequately address topics.	The topic is addressed, with less complexity in sentence structure or variety.	Tries to use circumlocution and a verity of descriptions to address the topic, but sentences are simple and verbs are repeated.
